## What are social impacts? What is Social Impact Assessment?

- ightarrow 'Social impacts' generally refer to the consequences that people experience when a new project brings change' (DPIE, 2021).
- ightarrow Social Impact Assessment aims to identify, predict and evaluate likely social impacts
- arising from a project and propose responses to the predicted impacts.
- $\rightarrow$  This is one of the technical assessments completed as part of the EIS



The SIA Process	
Background	<ul> <li>Desktop review of project information, information relating to the social context and comparative studies</li> </ul>
Impact Scoping	<ul> <li>Identification and preliminary assessment of the likely social impacts of the project</li> <li>Identification of the social 'area of influence'</li> </ul>
Community and Stakeholder Engagement	<ul> <li>Targeted interviews with key stakeholders</li> </ul>
Baseline	<ul> <li>Collation of key statistics and information relating to the social area of influence</li> </ul>
Impact Assessment	<ul> <li>Review of other EIS technical studies, stakeholder and community engagement findings</li> <li>Evaluation of the significance of identified potential social impacts</li> </ul>
Social Impact Enhancement and Mitigation	<ul> <li>Determine management measures and opportunity strategies to minimise significant negative impacts and enhance significant positive impacts</li> </ul>
